## ***2010 Pedders Khanacross Series***



### **What is Khanacross?**

Khanacross is a very inexpensive introductory level form of motorsport conducted on an unsealed surface which involves a series of timed tests on various track layouts. A normal road car is suitable. Up to 4 drivers can enter & drive the same car.

### **What do I need to compete?**

- MSCT Club Membership
- CAMS competition license. 2NS (Non speed) required for Khanacross, Motorkhana & Drifting practice events.
- Neck to wrist to ankle clothing, covered shoes & an approved helmet.
- Vehicle must be mechanically sound, especially brakes, steering & tyres.

### **What does it cost?**

- MSCT membership: adult \$45, junior \$25 & family \$65
- CAMS competition license 2NS: adult \$50, junior \$13
- Khanacross entry: adult \$40, junior \$20
- Motorkhanas entry adult \$30, junior \$15
- Note costs subjective to change.

### **What to do on the day?**

1. Fill out entry form, pay event entry fee & produce current & valid CAMS license & club membership.
2. Line up car for scrutineering to check for safety & eligibility between 8.30am-9.30am.
3. Attend compulsory drivers briefing.
4. Drive a non-competition observation/familisation lap of the course.
5. Line up in allocated running order ready for individual tests.
6. Remember to have fun
7. Khanacross events consist of 4 to 5 tests which are up to 1.5km in length.
8. Finish around 3-4pm

## **My vehicle and scrutiny, it's for your safety!**

Vehicle scrutiny is part of all CAMS sanctioned Motorsport and it's in place to help ensure your safety and the safety of other at these events.

- Attend a scheduled individual scrutineering session (details will be provided at your first event)

**NOTE:** All competitors must attend this session before entering their second Khanacross in the series.

At the first event, a log book will be issued for each vehicle, and this log book must be validated and presented at every scrutineering session. Replacement log books are available at a cost of \$15.00 per log book.
