Your Responsibility as a Spectator...

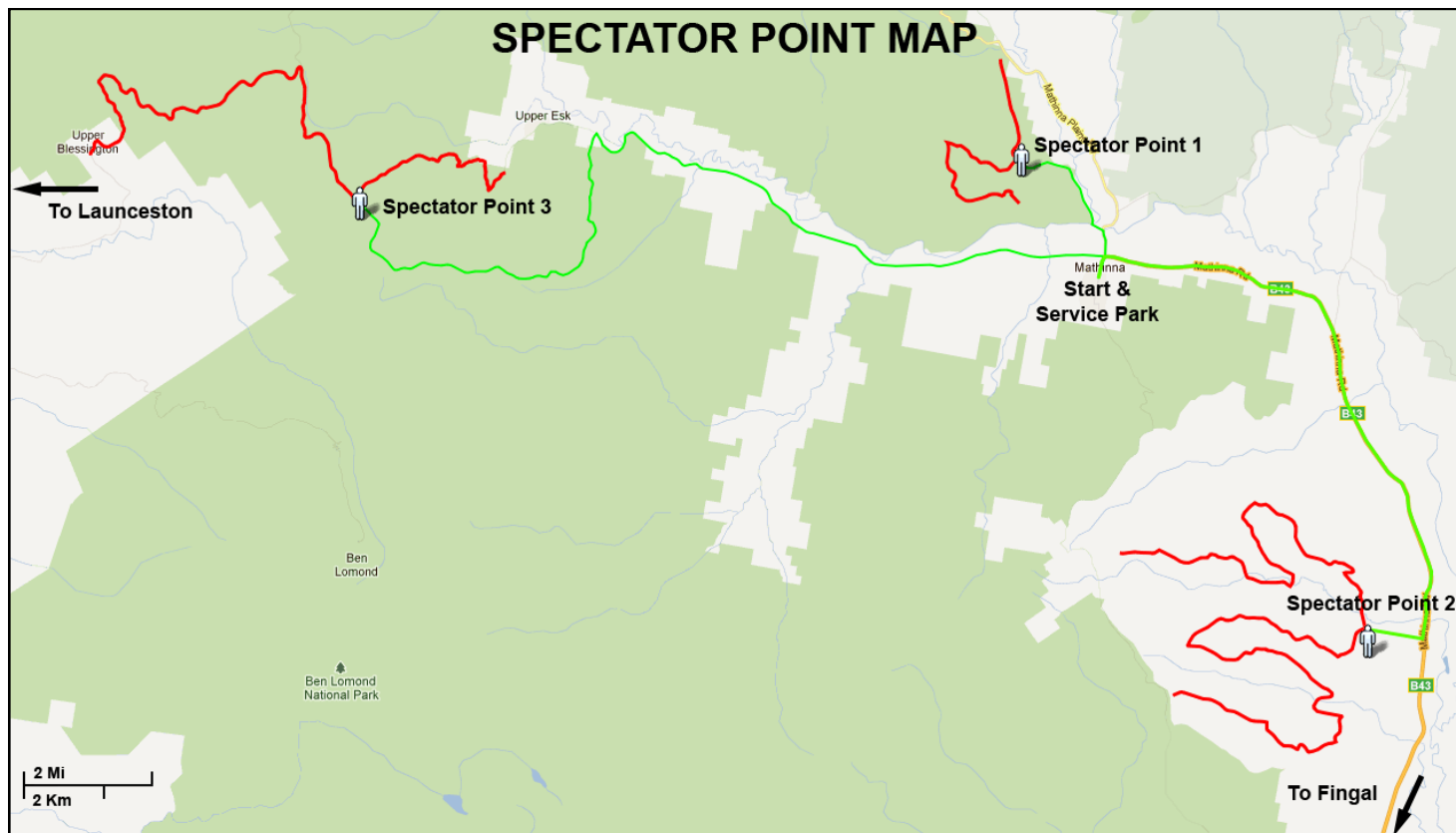
Spectators are reminded that motor sport is dangerous and accidents can happen.

7. If you have young children with you please ensure they are under constant supervision.

Directions to Mathinna and Spectator Points

The fastest way to get to Mathinna is via Fingal.

Traveling on the Midlands Hwy (A1), navigate to the Esk Hwy (A4) (Approx 11 Km north of Campbell Town). Drive 52.3 Km to Fingal and turn left onto Mathinna Rd (B43). Drive 1.7 Km and turn right to stay on Mathinna Rd. Continue 23.9 Km and turn left into High St. Drive 500 Metres and turn right into the service park (Football Oval).

There are no facilities at the spectator points, toilets are located at the service park. Food and drinks will also be available in the service park.

Spectator Point 2

First Car Due SS4 - 11:15am, SS8 - 2:30pm

Turn left out of the Service Park onto High St and drive north for 500 Metres. Give way then turn right onto Mathinna Plains Rd (B43). Drive 14.7 Km and turn right into Pig Rd. Follow main gravel road for 1.4 Km to the spectator point. Follow all instructions from the safety official's in the green vests.

Spectator Point 1

First Car Due SS3 - 10:15am

Turn left out of the Service Park onto High St and drive north for 500 Metres. Give way then go straight on through the intersection onto Mathinna Plains Rd. Drive 700 Metres then after crossing a narrow bridge immediately turn left into Eton Rd (Griffin Camping Area 6 Km). Follow the main gravel road 1.9 Km and keep right on Eton Rd (Ignore Griffin Rd on left). Continue 1.2 Km to the spectator point. Follow all instructions from the safety official's in the green vests.

Spectator Point 3

First Car Due SS10 - 4:15pm

Turn left out of the Service Park onto High St and drive north for 500 metres. Give way then turn left onto Upper Esk Rd (C401). Drive 14.6 Km and turn left onto Gunns Rd (C401). Follow the main gravel road for 5.3 Km to the spectator point. Follow all instructions from the safety official's in the green vests.
